Having returned to university to study music he spent the next thirty years teaching music, latterly at Bryanston School. He is an experienced singer and conductor, and although retired from full-time teaching, he is in great demand as a guest conductor and adjudicator—and frequently to be found in his garden shed.

After Ashby-de-la-Zouch Grammar School he went to Oxford to study music and was assistant organist at the Cathedral.
