







Making Maestros! A development event for choral conductors with Gregory Rose

Making Maestros is a masterclass designed for both new and experienced choral conductors. In addition to coaching in orchestral conducting and the adaptations necessary when conducting works for orchestra and choir together, this course offers the rare opportunity to practise these techniques with a live orchestra and choir, as well as the chance to demonstrate these skills in front of an audience!

- > **Saturday** will include an introduction to working with orchestras aimed at choral conductors. Participants will work on their selected passages under the instruction of Gregory Rose, with pianist Lynnette Newman.
- > **Sunday** will see participants developing their techniques further with a live orchestra and choir: Reading Symphony Orchestra with singers from local Making Music member groups.
- A **showcase concert** will be held on Sunday evening to demonstrate to the public the different techniques covered in the course.

Gregory Rose is Professor of Conducting at Trinity College of Music. He has conducted for opera, orchestras and choirs in the UK, including the BBC Singers, Jupiter Orchestra, London Philharmonic Orchestra, COMA London Orchestra, and abroad including the Netherlands Radio Choir, Finnish Radio Symphony Orchestra and St Petersburg Symphony. He has recorded for many international television and radio stations and, among others, for the recording companies Chandos and Naxos, as well as conducting Singcircle at two BBC Promenade concerts.

Repertoire will be extracts from Elgar's Music Makers and Dvorak's Tae Deum. Music will be available in advance.
