RALPH ALLWOOD

After 26 years as Precentor and Director of Music at Eton College, Ralph Allwood left Eton in 2011 to pursue freelance activities and to co-found Inner Voices, a choir for young people from ten Inner London state schools. He continues as Director of the Eton Choral Courses and the Rodolfus Choir, a young choir made up of the best singers from the last four or five years' Eton Choral Courses.

Ralph leads choral workshops all over the world, and is a judge for the Llangollen International Eisteddfod. As a choral consultant he is a regular visitor to several University and College choirs, including Wellington College.

He is a choral advisor for Novello and Co. and the National Youth Choir of Great Britain and is on the board of the Voices Foundation. He is an advisor for the Malcolm Arnold Academy, a trustee of Schola Cantorum of Oxford and of Tewkesbury, and a patron of Worcester International Festival of Youth Choirs.



In 2002 Ralph was made Honorary Fellow of the Royal School of Church Music, and in 2003 an Honorary Associate of the Royal Academy of Music. He was made an MBE in the 2012 New Years' Honours and has been awarded an honorary Doctor of Music by the University of Aberdeen. He took up the post of Director of Chapel Music in the Old Royal Naval Chapel in Greenwich in August 2012 and appeared in BBC Two's 'The Choir: Sing While You Work' as a choral consultant and judge in autumn 2012.
