

Train

If you are travelling by train, the nearest train station to Venue Cymru or any hotels within Llandudno is Llandudno train station. The train station is shown in the map below at point A and Venue Cymru at point B.



Buses

Buses are very regular throughout Llandudno with the main bus route being the number 12 running from Llandudno to Rhyl via Rhos On Sea, Colwyn Bay and Abergele. If you are planning any travel via bus please take a look at www.arrivabus.co.uk to look at timetables and routes.

Car

If travelling by car to Venue Cymru and using satellite navigation system the address is:

There is parking available along the promenade at the front of Venue Cymru or a car park to the rear (Both Pay and Display areas).

Things to do

If you want to venture out of Llandudno why not take a visit to Snowdonia Mountains, the highest mountain range in Wales. North Wales also is home to the beautiful Bodnant gardens that covers 80 acres but if you're looking for something more active and thrilling you could take a trip into the tree tops at Tree Top Adventure in Betws-y-Coed (no injuries before the competitions though please!)
