Choral Scholarships 2015-16

Four Choral Scholarships (SATB) of £1200 are available to undergraduate and postgraduate students for the academic year 2015-16. Principal duties are a weekly Sunday service with the church choir.



About All Saints' Choir

All Saints' has a strong choral tradition, led by its excellent choir of professional and volunteer singers. The choir is conducted by the Director of Music, Patrick Allies, and accompanied by the Assistant Director of Music, Christopher Woodward.

About All Saints' Church

We are a Church of England church in the liberal Catholic Anglican tradition, and we welcome people of all Christian traditions and backgrounds. We aim to be a place of spiritual, intellectual and emotional refreshment. It is expected that Choral Scholars will become part of the church community for the year, both within the choir and in the broader congregation.

Rehearsals and Services

Choral Scholars will be required to sing at one Sunday service per week during term time. This will most often be a morning service (9.30am rehearsal for a 10.30am service), but may occasionally take the form of an evensong (5pm rehearsal for a 6pm service). In addition, Choral Scholars will need to sing at five other major services: Carol Service; Midnight Mass; Christmas Day; Ash Wednesday; Maundy Thursday.

Remuneration

Choral Scholars will receive an annual sum of £1200, paid in three instalments. They will also have the opportunity of earning additional fees by singing at weddings, funerals and memorial services.
