The 1725 St John Passion contains many beautiful choruses and chorales not found in the 'standard' version and we will be exploring these, paying close attention to Bach's treatment of the German text. The workshop will begin with a gentle vocal and physical warm-up, and will end with an informal sing-through/performance of the music studied.

Our workshop is open to all, although some prior choral experience and a familiarity with reading sheet music is recommended. Music will be provided on the day, and can also be sent out in advance as a pdf.
